Applicant anticipates starting this project by _____ and will complete the project by _____. Applicant agrees that it will not leave any open excavation over night, except as specifically provided for in this agreement. Applicant further agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Sheridan and its officers and employee's from and against any liability, claims, demands and expenses including court costs and reasonable attorney fees on account of any injury, loss, damage or death which arises out of or is in any manner related to the work associated with the street cut permit.
2. Applicant shall notify the Sheridan Police Department dispatch center prior to commencement and upon completion of work each day. (303) 762-2211
3. Applicant shall not commence work until it has submitted and the City has approved a traffic control plan. All traffic restrictions must be completed as approved on the traffic control plan. Any variation from the approved plan may result in work being stopped by the City until such time as the approved traffic restrictions are in place. All signage and equipment shall meet the requirements and be used as set forth in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
4. Applicant shall provide flag personnel for the project, if required
5. No work will be allowed before 8:00 AM and all work and traffic restrictions must be completed before 4:00 PM.
6. Applicant shall notify the Public Works Department for inspection prior to asphaltting the excavation area. (303) 437-0073
7. Flo-fill is required for all backfill of the excavation area. No earthen backfill will be allowed.
8. All excavations must either be completed and filled the same day as opened except that if a project must be extended the applicant must, on a daily basis, be either back filled and a temporary cold patch must be in place or steel plating installed. Emergency excavations remaining open beyond the day of initial work may be permitted only upon the prior approval of the City's Public Works Department.
9. All permanent replacement patches must be 6 inches in depth of the same material as originally removed.
10. No project will be allowed to last more than three (3) calendar days.
11. No night work will be allowed without the express written authorization of the Sheridan Police and Public Works Departments.
12. The City in the exercise of its police powers reserves all rights to suspend or terminate all permit activities due to an emergency of any nature or weather conditions, natural hazards, applicants non-compliance with the permits terms and conditions or other activities requiring that the street be left open.
13. In the event the applicant should fail to provide adequate traffic control, and the City should have to provide assistance in traffic control, the applicant shall be liable for all costs and services provided by the City of Sheridan.
14. Applicant agrees that the release of the surety bond or any portion thereof is contingent upon the City's determination that the street has been restored to its pre-existing condition and or any costs and expenses incurred by the City in restoring the street to its pre-existing condition.
