After a man was sentenced to 34 months in prison for rape, his case made it to the higher court where the conviction was overturned. The Chief Judge argued that since the victim was wearing tight jeans, she must have consented due to having to help the perpetrator remove such tight pants. The women of the Italian Parliament protested by wearing jeans as a visible means of protest against the misconceptions involved with sexual assault. It has since become a world-wide movement.
