

Dear Sheridan Residents,

I am pleased to announce the launch of DrivingChange, the new name for the voter-approved Sheridan Bond Improvements Program.



This bond initiative was passed on the November 2015 ballot, and is crucial for our community for a variety of reasons:

- \* 51% of our paved roadways need to be completely replaced
- \* 40+ of Sheridan's streets are in need of repair and/or reconstruction
- \* 9 areas require storm pipe and inlets to solve serious drainage problems



**Sheridan Bond Improvements Program Launches Project Name DrivingChange**

The City of Sheridan is excited to announce **DrivingChange**, the new name of the voter-approved Sheridan Bond Improvements Program. The purpose of **DrivingChange** is to enhance our community through a series of reconstruction projects addressing street, bridge, drainage and stormwater issues.

The name **DrivingChange** was chosen to signify how Sheridan is moving

ahead to change the transportation issues our community faces. Last November, voters approved this bond initiative which is critical because of the current condition of our streets, crumbling sidewalks, and drainage issues.

**DrivingChange** will result in improved vehicle and pedestrian safety, reduced wear and tear on vehicles, stronger property values, and a greater ability to attract and retain businesses.

"We are thrilled the citizens of Sheridan passed this bond measure," said City of Sheridan Mayor Dallas Hall. "Sheridan citizens understand the importance of improving and repairing our streets. Visible construction activity related to this bond starts within the next few months."

**DrivingChange** kicks-off with the first two project areas scheduled to start construction in May and June:

**Zone 1A** - West Princeton Place, South Clay Street, South Irving Street: Work begins in this area in May addressing street rehabilitation and drainage improvements.

**Zone 1B** - The "Bottoms": Anticipated in early summer, work begins on the area known as the "Bottoms," north of US Hwy 285 between Zuni St. and the Platte River addressing the storm drainage system and street reconstruction.

Citizens are encouraged to attend the DrivingChange kick-off public meeting on May 11 to learn more about the program, and specifically about upcoming changes in their neighborhoods, and how these changes will benefit their community.
