Traffic Impacts for Week of March 19

Alley #2 Closure

- Alley #2 (between S. Quivas Street and South Platte River Drive West) will be closed until Friday, March 24 (tentatively), for drainage work. Residents and businesses will not have access to this location. Alley #2 is located between W. Hamilton Place and W. Girard Avenue.

Daily Lane Restriction on West Girton Avenue

- Alternating lane restriction on West Girton Avenue between S. Quivas Street and S. Umatilla Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, March 20 until Friday, March 31 (weekdays) for roadway grading and reconditioning. Watch for flaggers directing traffic.

Daily Lane Restrictions on W. Girard Avenue

- Daily lane restriction at W. Girard Avenue between S. Quivas Street and S. Umatilla Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, March 20 until Friday, March 31 (weekdays) for drainage work.

Full Closure on W. Girard Avenue (Local Traffic Only)

- West Girard Avenue will be closed between South Platte River Drive (West) and S. Quivas Street for construction activities until late March.

South Platte River Drive Closure

- South Platte River Drive is closed between Hamilton and Girard until mid-April for drainage and roadway work.
 - Motorists will be detoured over Hamilton Bridge and Dartmouth Avenue. North of the closure to Dartmouth, access will be open to local traffic only.

Partial Closure of South Platte River Trail Necessary for Construction

- The South Platte River Bike Trail is closed from Dartmouth Avenue to south of the Hamilton Bridge until late April.
 - Cyclists will be detoured around on Hamilton Bridge and the pedestrian bridge on Dry Creek Trail.
 - Share the road signs will be posted to ensure motorists are aware of increased bike traffic. Barrier will be used to enforce the closure.

Coffee With Kraemer

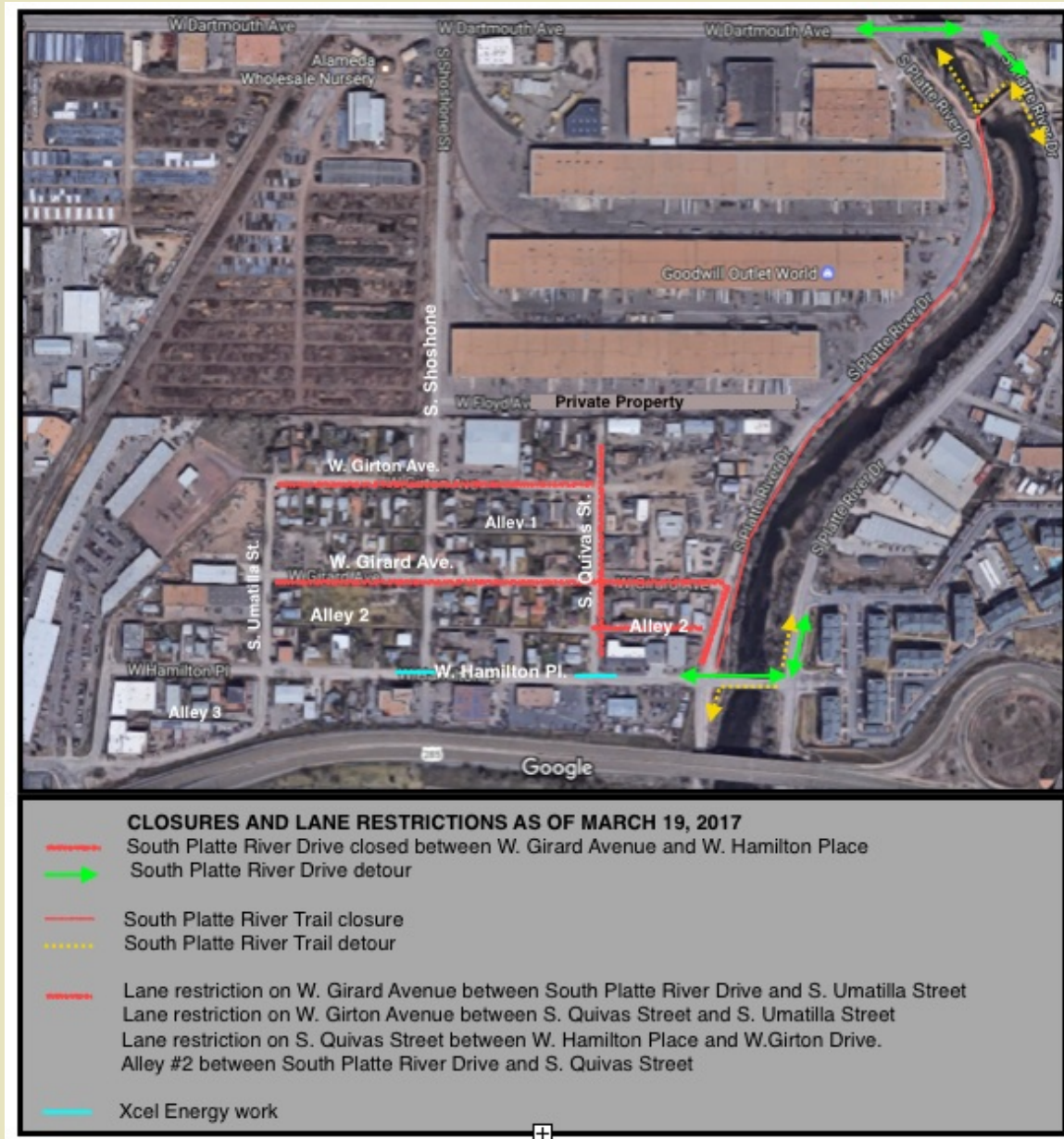

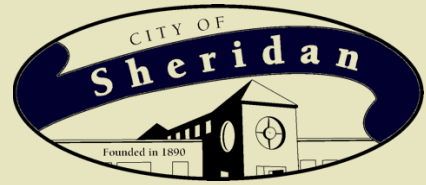
Construction schedules are subject to change based on weather/
unforeseen circumstances and schedule changes.

- South Platte River Drive closed between W. Hamilton Place and W. Girard Avenue until mid-April for drainage and roadway work.
- Partial closure South Platte River Trail between Dartmouth Avenue and south of the Hamilton Bridge until late April for construction.
- West Girard Avenue will be closed between South Platte River Drive (West) and S. Quivas Street for construction activities until late March.
- Daily lane restriction at W. Girard Avenue between S. Quivas Street and S. Umatilla Street from 7 a.m to 5 p.m., Monday, Mar. 20 until Friday, Mar. 31 (weekdays) for drainage work.
- Alternating lane restriction on West Girton Avenue between S. Quivas Street and S. Umatilla Street from 7 a.m to 5 p.m., Monday, Mar. 20 until Friday, Mar. 31 (weekdays) for roadway grading and reconditioning.

- Daily lane restriction on W. Hamilton Place at S. Quivas Street for utility work from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
