<p>As paving occurs in your neighborhood, please remember it is very important to stay off the street until the contractor opens it up again. When installed, asphalt is approximately 300 degrees and can take several hours to cool to a safe temperature. Also, keep pets and children away from the asphalt as it could cause serious injury.</p> <p>Daily Restrictions:</p> <p><u>7 a.m to 5 p.m.</u> <u>Monday, July 17 through Friday, July 21</u></p> <p>Daily lane restriction on Natches Court for grading and paving operations</p> <p>Daily lane restrictions on S. Umatilla Street between Alley 2 and W. Girton Avenue for pipe installation. Business access will be maintained.</p> <p>Full Closures:</p> <p><u>24 Hour Closure</u> <u>Monday, July 17 through Saturday, July 22</u></p> <p>Full closure of Shoshone Street between W. Hamilton Place and W. Girard Avenue for pipe installation. Follow detour signs to South Platte Drive.</p>	<p>Concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk operations have started. Please park on adjacent blocks or across the street once concrete has been placed. The concrete requires a 5 to 7 day cure time prior to allowing vehicles to drive on it.</p> <p>As paving occurs in your neighborhood, please remember it is very important to stay off the street until the contractor opens it up again. When installed, asphalt is approximately 300 degrees and can take several hours to cool to a safe temperature. 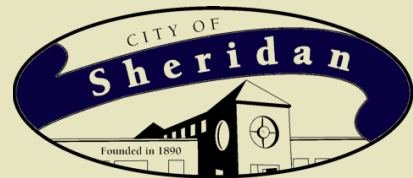
Upcoming Meetings:
