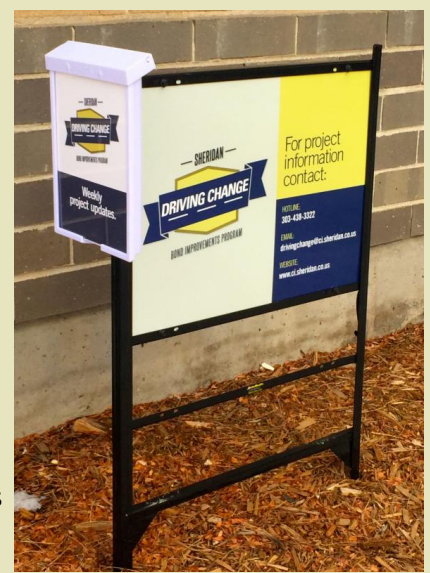

The DrivingChange Bond Improvements Program is improving the Alice Terry, Rose Gardens and Fort Logan/Northgate neighborhoods, and S. Irving Street west to Lowell Boulevard and the South Santa Fe Business Park with roadway replacement, curbs, gutters, and sidewalk replacement. The project is anticipated to be completed Fall 2018. 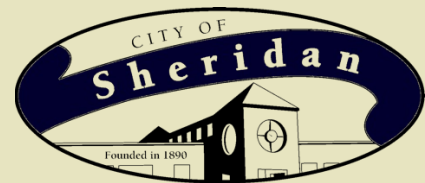
## Important Information:

The City of Sheridan and the DrivingChange team remind residents that while new sidewalks, curbs and gutters look great -- the use of salts, de-icers and other chemicals can quickly corrode and damage them. Please do not use any chemicals (salts, de-icers, etc.) on the new sidewalks, curbs and gutters for one year after installation. When the City receives a significant amount of cumulative snow cover, it is the resident and businesses responsible to shovel their sidewalk within 24 hours.
