



PROJECT FACT SHEET

Federal West Neighborhood

The DrivingChange Bond Improvements Program is improving the Federal West Neighborhood by repairing and repaving the streets, storm sewer work, and repairing and improving curbs and sidewalks.

BACKGROUND:

This November 3, 2015 bond initiative passed by more than half of voters. *DrivingChange* is critical for the community because 75 percent of Sheridan's streets are in fair or poor condition, with crumbling sidewalks, drainage issues causing water damage, and areas with high accident rates and traffic congestion. Each year these issues weren't addressed, the cost for repairs increased by more than \$1 million.

Construction cost for all the projects combined is estimated at \$31 million and will take approximately four years to complete with an estimated monthly tax impact of \$9.92 per \$100,000 of a home's actual market value.

BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY:

- Improved vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Reduced wear and tear on vehicles
- Potential for stronger property values
- Greater ability to attract and retain businesses. Improved safety and effectiveness of emergency responders.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

DrivingChange will be solving many of the current transportation-related challenges our community faces such as:

- Pothole repair
- Street resurfacing
- Bridge repair
- Fixing drainage issues by replacing sidewalks, curbs and gutters
- Stormwater solutions such as storm pipes and inlets
- Alleviating traffic congestion and accident rates with addition of some four-way stop signs and street lights, redefining intersection boundaries, and repositioning certain center islands.

The community will remain informed about each of the construction projects and impacts with ongoing articles in the *Sheridan News*, posts to the City website, emailed construction updates, and quarterly e-newsletters.

2017 Projects:

- Federal West Neighborhood (*see map*)
 - Area from W. Hampden Avenue to W. Oxford Avenue and from S. Irving Street to S. Federal Boulevard
 - Work includes: Roadway repair and repaving, curb and sidewalk repairs, and minor storm sewer work
 - Project start April 2017. Tentative completion November 2017

- Goat Hill Neighborhood
 - Area from W. Hampden Avenue to W. Dartmouth Avenue and from S. Federal Boulevard to Zuni Street
 - Work includes: Roadway repair and repaving, curb and gutter additions, and sidewalk replacement
- The Bottoms Neighborhood - construction began January 30, 2017
 - Addressing storm drainage system and street reconstruction
- 3600 Block of South Bryant Street, south of US 285
- Mansfield and Decatur Street from Federal Boulevard to Clay Street

2018 Projects: All remaining streets

- Irving Street to Lowell and US 285 to Mansfield
- Oxford/Santa Fe Industrial Area, including Oxford from S. Clay Street to Santa Fe Drive
- Rose Garden Neighborhood (S. Dale Court, S. Decatur Street, Eliot Street, and S. Clay Street from Oxford to S. Federal Boulevard)
- Oxford South to Dill and Lowell to S. Federal Boulevard
